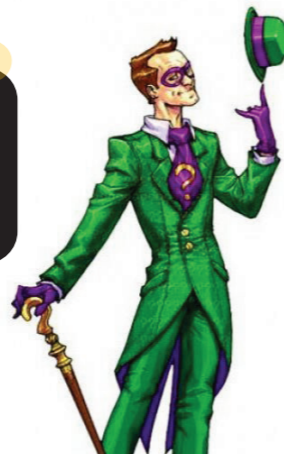


# The Puzzler Page
